EARLY YEARS EDUCATION

LEARNING AND DEVELOPMENT THROUGH PLAY

Little Pumpkins Nursery Centres offers a large range of stimulating activities and experiences to cater for your child's emotional, physical and social development, both individually and within groups.

There are seven areas of learning and development that must shape educational programmes in early years settings. All areas of learning and development are important and inter-connected. Educational programmes must involve activities and experiences for children, as follows: -





COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

to experience a rich language environment; to develop their confidence and skills in expressing themselves; and to speak and listen in a range of situations.



PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

to be active and interactive; and to develop their co-ordination, control, and movement. Children must also be helped to understand the importance of physical activity, and to make healthy choices in relation to food.



PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

to develop a positive sense of themselves, and others; to form positive relationships and develop respect for others; to develop social skills and learn how to manage their feelings, to understand appropriate group behavior and to have confidence in their abilities.



LITERACY DEVELOPMENT

to link sounds and letters and begin to read and write. Children must be given access to a range of reading materials (books, poems, other written materials) to ignite their interest.



MATHEMATICS

to develop and improve their skills in counting and using numbers, simple addition and subtraction problems; and to describe shapes, spaces and measures.



UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

to make sense of their physical world and their community through opportunities to explore, observe and find out about people, places, technology and the environment.



EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials, as well as providing opportunities for sharing their thoughts and feelings through a variety of activities in art, music, dance, role play and technology.



CHILD SAFEGUARDING

EVERY CHILD MATTERS

Safeguarding and promoting children's welfare forms a large part of our statutory responsibilities and covers most of the requirements of our registration with Ofsted.

All children deserve the opportunity to achieve their full potential. We follow the framework of the Every Child Matters government green paper, which is structured around five outcomes, which are key to a child's well being.

Educating our young children and supporting them to lead, happy, healthy and successful lives, both now and in the future are at the very heart of what we do at Little Pumpkins Nursery.

Stay safe - looking after the children's welfare and ensuring a safe environment



Be healthy - safeguarding and promoting children's health and well being



Enjoy and achieve – supporting the children in their learning and development



Make a positive contribution – working together with parents, encouraging children to play a beneficial part in their nursery and community



Organisation – ensuring all government policies, procedures and practices are strictly followed.

OUR EXPERT TEAM

QUALIFIED STAFF FOR QUALITY CARE

At Little Pumpkins we believe that a happy and caring atmosphere is essential. To promote this we take great care in choosing responsible, conscientious and professional staff that is particularly able to gain the confidence of young children.

Our high standards involve comprehensive induction programme covering subjects such as Paediatric First Aid, Basic Food Hygiene and the extensive nursery practices to familiarise themselves with our standards and procedures maintained with regular appraisals and staff training.

The children to staff ratios are strictly maintained as laid down by the Children's Act and OFSTED. We operate a key carer system enabling us to meet your child's individual needs.

This understanding and familiarity leads to responsive care and greater emotional stability of the child.

The core team is qualified to N.N.E.B/NVQ 3 or equivalent. In addition we support local colleges who may place students with us for assessment under strict supervision.





HEALTHY EATING

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

We provide varied and well-balanced meals that are low in salt, sugar and saturated fat and high in fibre and vitamins. Little Pumpkins seeks professional advice from a nutritionist and recognised for healthy eating for under 5's.

A choice of non-sugared cereals, milk and whole meal toast are offered for breakfast. Milk and water are offered to the children at every meal and snack time and throughout the day. To maintain healthy teeth we do not include juices.

Mid morning and mid afternoon snacks consist of various fruit options, including dried apricots and raisins, breadsticks and rice cakes, dips with a choice of either milk or water to drink.

ALL food is prepared freshly on the premises in our dedicated nursery kitchen by our full-time qualified nursery cook. At Little Pumpkins, lunch is always a balanced hot meal, served with fresh vegetables, and cooked on site. Pudding might be apple crumble, freshly baked rice pudding, or homemade pear and apricot muffins.

In negotiation with parent's wishes, we will also supply pureed fruit and vegetables for weaning babies. Formula milk should be provided to maintain continuity.



5 STAR RATING

Environmental Health Officers, trained in the latest food safety, hygiene and management procedures, conduct random inspections on any companies serving food on their premises. Following each inspection, a star rating between 1 and 5 is awarded, with five being the highest.

The nurseries were recently inspected and were awarded a 5 star rating.


A FUN SAFE ENVIRONMENT
